NAMING Opportunities

The Community Foundation Building, located at 324 SE 24th Street, has naming opportunities should a business or individual desire to make a legacy gift to the community. We would offer a media event and release as well as a ribbon cutting and social media engagement to celebrate this generous gift.

NONPROFIT RESOURCE CENTER BUILDING - \$500,000 (one time gift)

The Nonprofit Resource Center, hub of local nonprofit trainings and resources, is strategically located off US 441 just outside of Downtown Ocala. We provide a variety of services to local nonprofits in the Resource Center including Grant Services, Finance and Accounting Counseling, Communication/PR/Marketing Counseling, Cox Video training, and board and committee meeting space.

The naming opportunities below cover a 2-year period with invoicing spread out annually. With the naming of the room, a media release and social media will be created to announce this commitment.

TRAINING ROOM- \$50,000

Our training room seats up to 40 (pre-social distancing) and hosts many professional development sessions as well as board and committee meetings for several local nonprofits. It also serves as the hub for our annual Give4Marion event. Upwards of 250 unique individuals use the training room annually.

EXECUTIVE BOARD ROOM- \$25.000

The Foundation utilizes the Executive Board Room for introduction meetings to those in the community and nonprofit executive meetings. This spacious room seats up to 10 comfortably and has state of the art technology for running presentations.

STRATEGY ROOM- \$10,000

The Strategy Room is designed for a more informal setting for nonprofits to collaborate or discuss detailed policy. Equipped with a large white board for brainstorming, this room is perfect for planning and comfortably seats six.
